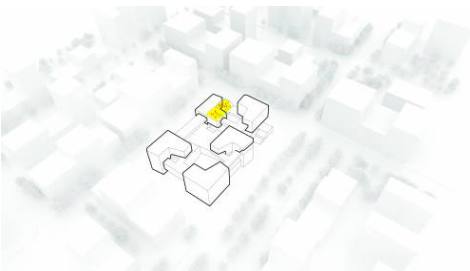
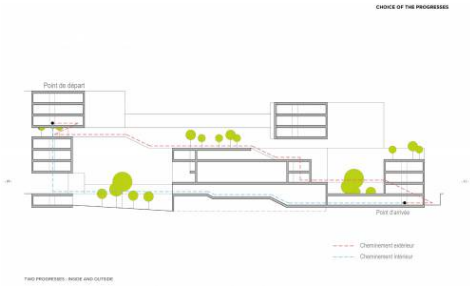

Environmental Ambitions

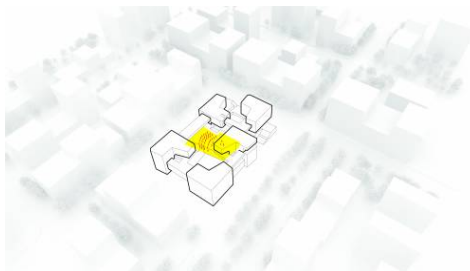

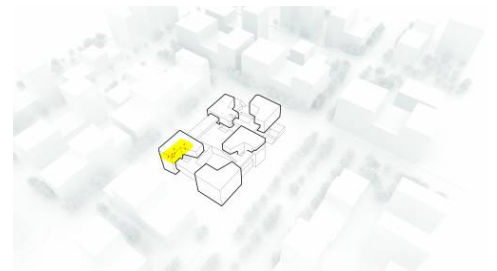
